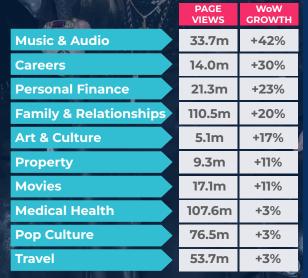


The Lionesses take home the trophy in the Euro's Final









TOPICAL NEWS

The passing of 'The Prince of Darkness', Ozzy Osbourne, has made waves across the news, as tributes pour in for the Black Sabbath star. As a result, **Music & Audio** has seen a sharp uplift of +42%, with **Hard Rock** soaring 7.4x.

Sadly, Ozzy's passing wasn't the only shock for Brits this week – wrestling icon Hulk Hogan also passed later in the week. Wrestling page views have skyrocketed 16.3x as fans of the sport caught up on the details of his impact. Meanwhile, Obituaries (Pop Culture) is up 3.3x as fans mourn and celebrate both Ozzv and Hulk's legacies.

Elsewhere, the upcoming announcement around changes to the state pension age has caused a wave of concern, with those affected eager to understand what's ahead. As a result, Careers is up 30% WoW, Retirement has jumped 80%, Career Planning is up 3x, and Retirement Planning (Personal Finance) has climbed 2.5x.

On a similar note, rumours of tax law changes for households with over £14.5k in savings have driven a sharp increase in **Personal Finance** page views – up 23%. **Saving** content has jumped 58% and **Personal Taxes** has seen an 8% boost. Expect further growth for the category when the Bank of England next sets interests rates early next month.

SEASONAL EVENTS

The Lionesses triumphed over Spain in a thrilling Euros Final last night. With both the semi-final and final in the same week, Football users increased by 10% week-on-week, with Sunday's final being the highest day for engagement. Page views were 12% higher compared to Saturday. Expect further growth this week, with engagement likely to be 2-4x higher as celebrations, including an open-top bus parade through London, and post-competition fallout continue.

In other sporting news, the British & Irish Lions secured a controversial last-minute win in their Test series match against Australia, driving **Rugby** page views up by 22%.

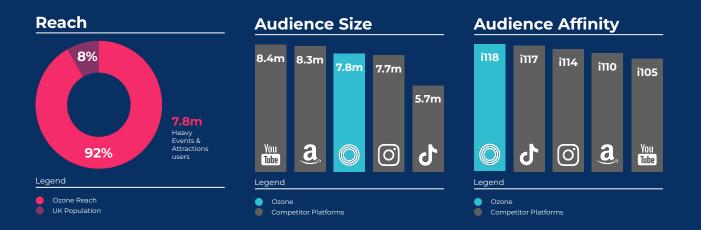
The summer holidays are in full swing, with **Family & Relationships** seeing an action-packed 20% uplift as parents look for ways to spend time with their children. Meanwhile, **Travel** is up a further 3% this week, and **Travelling with Kids** has soared by 99% as families get holiday ready.

The Edinburgh Fringe Festival kicks off this week and is already causing a stir, with the infamous 'Funniest Joke Award' scrapped, driving **Humour & Satire** (Pop Culture) up 37% as readers dig into why.
